We are pleased that you have been chosen to exhibit your science project at the Region 1 Science and Engineering Fair. We appreciate the time and effort you have spent working on your project. This letter should help you prepare for entry into the Regional Fair.

When you arrive on campus, please report to the registration desk in the Campus Center (see campus map). You will receive an exhibit number and a name badge. The Fair will be held in the Campus Center Gym.

Your project should adhere to the size requirements as specified in the Rules and Regulations. Electrical outlets are limited so request electricity only if your project depends on it. Bring your own extension cords, power strips, tape, and any other supplies you may need.

Since this is a competition as well as an exhibit, students are expected to remain at the Fair from set-up time until the awards ceremony concludes. Wear comfortable clothing that is both neat and appropriate for a person who is presenting work to several judges. Come prepared to spend time waiting for judges to interview you. You may want to bring a good book.

Naturally, there will be time for you to meet your fellow exhibitors. This means social contact, new friends, and new ideas. This is a good way to learn what other people have accomplished. It will also provide you with an opportunity to explain your project in a more relaxed way, which will help you in your presentation to the judges.

Lunch is provided at no cost to you. You will not be allowed to leave the MCLA campus during the day. The campus book store will be open from 8:30 to 4:00pm. The phone number for emergencies only is (413) 662-5100.

Activities are planned after the judging and an Awards Ceremony with a guest speaker will conclude the day's activities.
