

FACULTY LECTURE AWARD

Guidelines:

- 1) A 2-3 page typed, double-spaced abstract should be submitted to the office of the Vice President for Academic Affairs. The abstract should include a clear summary of the main focus of the research, description of methodologies, and contributions to the discipline. Selection Committee readers will review the abstracts and readers outside the Committee will be solicited as necessary if research areas do not coincide with Committee member expertise.
- 2) Those who submit the three best abstracts will be asked to submit an essay not to exceed 20-pages, so that a final selection can be made. The essay should be typed and double-spaced.
- 3) Abstracts should be submitted by **January 15, 2010**.
- 4) Final essays *must* be submitted by **April 9, 2010** (Late essays will not be accepted).
- 5) Submissions should be made to the office of the Vice President for Academic Affairs.

Stipend:

The stipend for the winning lecture is \$1,500. In the instance in which the Selection Committee wishes to support more than one submission, the stipend will be split equally.

Presentation:

The winning essayist will present his/her paper as part of the Faculty Lecture Series. In addition, the winning manuscript, with the author's permission, will be published in The Mind's Eye.
