Syllabus Requirements

A syllabus is required for each course. The syllabus should contain, at minimum, your contact information, office hours, course title and description, course learning outcomes, grading scheme, statement about plagiarism, and a list of assignments with due dates.

Department Responsibilities

Academic departments are generally responsible for providing the following:

Office assignments, keys, and supplies.

Access to a desktop computer and printer.

Copier: Large runs are done at the Copy Center in Venable Hall.

Phone access.

Mail: Some departments receive mail, but you may be asked to go to your assigned mailbox in Venable Hall.

The department chairperson is responsible for conducting your classroom visitations.

Class cancellations & emergency procedures

Technology and Support

Each new employee must get an 'A' number from Human Resources, Mark Hopkins, first floor. You will need your 'A' number to set up your email account and get web access on campus. Go to http://techhelp.mcla.edu to set up your MCLA account.
