Subject: Retrieving your Personal Belongings

Dear Resident Student:

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we work out logistics related to MCLA's move to remote instruction and close residence areas for the remainder of the semester. This email addresses the processes for scheduling an appointment to retrieve your belongings from your residence.

1. Retrieving Your Personal Belongings from MLCA Residence Areas

You will be able to schedule a time to remove your personal belongings from Friday, March 20 through Friday, March 27 between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. This appointment process has been created to adhere to social distancing guidelines set by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control (CDC).

We are asking that you only bring ONE person with you to help you move out. Please limit interpersonal contact when you check in for your appointment. Because MCLA must follow social distancing guidelines, it is very important for you to not come to campus at a time for which you are not scheduled, and to arrive on time for your scheduled appointment. Please pack and leave your residence area as swiftly as possible so we can maintain the scheduled appointment times. If you use a key to enter your residence area and have not yet turned it in, please bring it back with you.
