## **BT Special Interest Housing Options**

### **Healthy Lifestyles Floor**

The Healthy Lifestyles floor is comprised of a group of students who want to live in a residential community with other students who embrace the concept of "wellness" (maintaining a balance between the physical, emotional and spiritual aspects of life). On the Healthy Lifestyles floor, residents agree to create and maintain an environment that is substance-free (no smoking, drinking, drugs or any related influences) and conducive to academic pursuits. The R.A. and members of the campus Wellness Committee work closely with the residents of this floor to plan weekly social activities; establish living agreements which encourage respect for all floor members; and engage in pursuits which help residents to learn more about themselves and others.

### **Quiet Floor**

The Quiet Floor consists of students who value a living environment that is conducive to academic pursuits. Students living on this floor mutually agree to refrain from creating disturbances at any time of day that might interfere with the ability to study and/or sleep in their rooms. Students choosing to live in this environment also share an interest in creating and participating in a community of scholars that transcend any particular course of study. Toward that end, students may work with their R.A to develop educational programs and relationships with faculty that transcend the walls of the classroom.

### **Coed Suites**

Berkshire Towers coed suites have been designed for returning students who wish to live in a mixed-gender environment. In coed suites, the bathroom is a single-use bathroom which can be locked when in use.

## HOOSAC HALL: Floor & Suite Information

All floors in Hoosac Hall will be open next year. All rooms on floors 2-7 will be available to returning students, except for the corner rooms ("01" "09" "10" and "18") and the "07" rooms which are reserved for the R.A. staff.
