

MCLA IS LOCATED IN THE HEART OF THE BERKSHIRES, SURROUNDED BY 10,000 ACRES OF SOME OF THE MOST PRISTINE FORESTS IN NEW ENGLAND.

On any given day, our students may be:

- Sampling fish at Clarksburg State Park
- Exploring old growth forests in Mohawk

 Trail State Forest
- Over Visiting the boreal forests on Mt. Greylock
- Mist netting songbirds on the flood plains of the Hoosic River
- Using trail cameras to sample deer and bears in forests protected by land trusts
- Snowshoeing into Eugene D. Moran Wildlife Management Area to look for overwintering birds
