Rockwell exhibit

NORTH ADAMS — Starting on June 24, the artwork of three generations of Rockwells will be exhibited in the Berkshires.

In addition to the work of Norman Rockwell at the Norman Rockwell Museum in Stockbridge, the work of his son, Jarvis Rockwell, and his granddaughter, Daisy Rockwell, will be on display in North Adams this summer and fall as part of DownStreet Art.

From June 24 to July 25, Daisy Rockwell's "Rasgulla," a display of Rasa paintings, will be in the Galerie Inqilab at 5 Holden St. Her father, Jarvis Rockwell, will present a pyramid of toys, scenes in vitrines, wall drawings and assemblage, in an exhibition titled "Maya III," at 73 Main St.

The Jarvis Rockwell retrospective will include work shown in Scottsdale, Ariz., art exhibited at the Massachusetts Museum of Contemporary Art in 2002, some of his work from the 1970s and '80s, as well as work that he is creating this summer in his 73 Main St. space.

Like her grandfather, Daisy Rockwell, of Hanover, N.H., paints portraits. However, her work is very different from Norman Rockwell's.

The third annual DownStreet Art will kick off in downtown North Adams on Thursday, June 24, from 6 to 9 p.m., with a massive block party celebrating the arts. There will be gallery exhibition openings, street musicians and specials at local businesses. The event is free; all of the participating artists will be in attendance. Info: downstreetart.org.
