## **APPLYING TO MCLA**

Thank you for your interest in Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts (MCLA)! We are pleased to welcome international students to our campus. Please read the following instructions very carefully and complete each step. Your application will be considered for a full-time degree program. Before you begin the process, please note: Unfortunately, MCLA is unable, under any circumstances, to provide financial aid to international students. In addition, the application fee cannot be waived.

# **Application Checklist**

## **Application Form**

An application for admission should be submitted directly to MCLA, or through the Common Application. The application fee is \$40.00. Payment may be made by check in US dollars, money order or by Master Card or Visa.

## **Academic Credentials**

Translations of transcripts from secondary school and all universities or colleges attended should be sent directly from an approved credential evaluation service to MCLA. A list of approved agencies can be found online at http://naces.org/members.htm. The translation must include proof of graduation from secondary school. Any college-level work must include American grade and credit hour equivalents for each course.

#### SATI

Freshmen applicants are required to submit official results of the SAT I from either the College Board or the above credential evaluation service. MCLA's CEEB number is 3521. Applicants who graduated from secondary school more than three years prior to the application date are exempt from the SATI requirement.

### **English Proficiency (TOEFL)**

Applicants for whom English is not a native language, and those who are not schooled primarily in English must submit proof of English language proficiency in the form of the Test of English as a Foreign Language or TOEFL. Official scores must be sent directly from the testing agency is required for acceptance. Those students whose native language or schooling is in English or transfer students who have completed at least six hours of college-level English composition at an American university or college will be exempt from the TOEFL.

#### **Certification of Finances**

Citizinship and Immagration regulations dictate that applicants complete the Certification of Finances form (see attached), verifying access to sufficient financial resources to attend the College. International students must pay out-of-state costs. Since the College is unable to provide financial aid to international students, the applicant must demonstrate adequate resources to meet yearly estimated expenses below:

# On-Campus Work

International students studying on an F-I visa in the United States are eligible to work in paid on-campus positions. Employment is not guaranteed. It is illegal for students on F-I visa to be employed otherwise. A student's potential earnings can NOT substitute for, nor be included, in the financial documentation.

## Financial Aid

Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts is unable, under any circumstances, to provide financial aid to international students. In addition, the application fee cannot be waived.

# Completing the Certification of Finances Form

All portions of the Certification of Finances form must be completed. The form will not be valid unless signed by the applicant. No other form may be substituted.

**Sources of Funds.** Each applicant must show the sources of financial support for the expected number of years until graduation (four years for freshmen). Students must demonstrate that the entire first year's expenses are currently on deposit or are being provided by their home government or agency. All sources of savings (personal, parental or those of an individual sponsor) must be verified by a bank official on official bank stationary. If funds are held in more than one financial institution, verification from each bank must be provided. Each financial institution must verify:

- the exact amount of balance in U.S. dollars
- the legal name of the bank the mailing address of the bank
- the name and title of the signing bank official
- the length of the banking relationship with the client
- and a telephone number where that official can be reached

# Completing the Sponsor Affidavit of Support

If the student has financial support from relatives, benefactors, or friends (known as sponsors), each separate source must fill out a Sponsor Affidavit of Support form. Affidavits must be submitted with proper documentation (as described above in the Certification of Finances section) of the sponsor's ability to provide the indicated resources. Each affidavit must be witnessed and notarized by a notary public.

# Joining Our Community

An admission decision on an international application cannot be made until all credentials, including the Certification of Finances form, have been submitted. All international applicants should apply as early as possible to ensure timely processing of their application. An I-20 form is issued only AFTER the applicant has been accepted and the appropriate enrollment deposit has been submitted.

## SEVIS Fee for I-20

Please note, all students and exchange visitors with an I-20 issuance date of September I, 2004 or later will be required to pay the SEVIS fee of \$200.00. You may pay with a check by mail, with a credit card via the internet. Please refer to http://www.ice.gov/sevis/i901/ for more information.
