Definitions

First Attempt

Successful completion during the student's initial enrollment in the course.

Second Attempt

Successful completion after one prior unsuccessful attempt.

Third Attempt

Successful completion after two prior unsuccessful attempts.

Unsuccessful Attempts Include

- Withdrawal (W)
- Failure (F)
- Any grade below the minimum course requirement
- Repeated enrollment in the same course

Transfer Students

Official transcripts from other institutions will be reviewed to determine final grades and course attempts when available.

Admissions Ranking Statement

The Radiologic Technology Program admits a limited number of students each year. Ranking points are used to objectively evaluate applicants based on academic achievement, prerequisite performance, and evidence of college success. Applicants with the highest overall ranking scores will be given priority consideration for admission. Meeting minimum admission requirements does not guarantee acceptance into the program.
