NETWORK SECURITY

The Certificate of Network Security (Cybersecurity) provides a foundation in networking, network security, troubleshooting, and problem-solving for computer networks. Students will learn about certifications such as the GIAC and GSEC; the program does not teach their specific outcomes. (21 Credits)
