

Articulation Agreement Between Hudson Valley Community College And Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts

Honors Program

This agreement is developed to enhance the transfer of students from the Honors program at Hudson Valley Community College to Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts. This articulation agreement will provide privileges and benefits to HVCC students as stated below. Students completing the Honors program at HVCC will be directly admitted into the Honors Program at MCLA.

MCLA guarantees the following privileges to HVCC students completing the program listed above:

- Admission to MCLA Honors Program above with a minimum of a 3.2 overall grade point average.
- Acceptance of three lower HVCC Honors courses (200 and below) with the remaining three upper level classes (300 and above) to be completed at MCLA
- Admission with junior status, based on credits accepted by MCLA.
- Opportunity to compete for a scholarship based on criteria and availability of funds.
- Pre-enrollment advisement on class selection and major program specifics.
- Consideration for early registration based on time of acceptance.
- Financial Aid estimates based on submission of required documents.
- Opportunity to apply to become a commonwealth scholar

Other conditions of these agreements:

- MCLA and HVCC will review and revise agreements including course requirement changes on an annual basis.
- MCLA and HVCC will publish articulation agreements in college publications and course catalogs.
- MCLA will host advising and enrollment sessions on HVCC campus throughout the
 academic year and at mutually agreed upon dates. HVCC will advertise sessions and
 advise students to participate in early enrollment sessions with MCLA.
- HVCC will advise students to apply by March 1st to ensure space availability for the fall term. Students interested in spring admission should apply by November 1st.
