



MCLA: Students with Disabilities

Faculty should include statements about academic accommodations in their course syllabus. Below are three sample options.

1. Any student who believes that they may need an accommodation based on the impact of a documented disability may be eligible for accommodations that provide equal access to educational programs at MCLA. Students are advised to contact The Office of Academic Support & Disability Resources at 413-662-5314 or stop by CSSE, Eldridge Hall to schedule an appointment. In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), the Office of Academic Support & Disability Resources will work with students to coordinate reasonable accommodations. Once accommodations have been determined, the student will be provided a copy of their accommodation plan to be given to each individual instructor. Students must fulfill all course requirements in order to receive passing grades in their classes, with or without reasonable accommodations. Please note that accommodations cannot be granted retroactively.

2. Students with disabilities who wish to access accommodations are advised to contact the Office of Academic Support & Disability Resources at 413-662-5314 or stop by CSSE, Eldridge Hall to schedule an appointment. The Office of Academic Support & Disability Resources will work individually with students to determine accommodations that are reasonable for them. Based on the students' documentation, an accommodation plan is developed to facilitate equal access. It is the responsibility of the student to deliver and discuss their accommodation plan with their professor.
